Guest speakers include leading scientists from the RIKEN Brain Science Institute (**Shun-Ichi Amari** and **Kazuhiro Yamakawa**), neurologists in the fields of cognition (**Jason Mattingly**) and epilepsy (**David Reutens**) and world leaders in the development of imaging techniques (**Zang-Hee Cho**) and computational neuroscience (**Peter Dayan**).
